This authorization and request is a consent to the release of such information under current and future laws, rules and regulations, including but not limited to the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996 ("HIPAA") and regulations promulgated pursuant thereunder.

How it Works

What Are the Responsibilities of the Volunteers/Participants?

- Fill out, sign, and return a Volunteer/Participant Waiver form **for each volunteer/participant** to adoptastreet@greenupashland.org
- Check the map available at <http://greenupashland.org/adoptastreetprogram.html> to make sure that the street(s) or street section(s) being adopted are not already being cleaned by other volunteers – streets that have been adopted are marked in **blue**
- When adopting street section(s), indicate the section(s) by listing the cross streets [e.g. West Union Street between Clark Street and Metropolitan Avenue]
- Confirm continued participation and obtain yellow Green Up Ashland trash bags on a monthly basis – yellow Green Up Ashland trash bags will be available at the skate park next to the Ashland Farmer's Market on the second Saturday of every month beginning in June:

October 14*	

*Note there is no Farmer's Market on October 14 – trash bags will still be available for pick-up

- Put used Green Up Ashland yellow trash bags curbside for pick-up on your regular town-assigned trash pick-up day

What Are the Responsibilities of the Town of Ashland?

- Purchase and provide yellow Green Up Ashland trash bags
- Ensure that Waste Management removes used Green Up Ashland yellow trash bags as part of regular trash pick-up
- Monitor the yellow Green Up Ashland trash bag pick-up volume as reported by Waste Management

What Are the Responsibilities of Green Up Ashland?

- Approve streets adopted by volunteers/participants
- Ensure that all volunteers/participants sign the Volunteer/Participant Waiver form
- Track volunteer/participant cleanup participation
- Hand out yellow Green Up Ashland trash bags each month and confirm continued volunteer/participant participation
